What Does it Mean to Predict Endings?

When you read, you try to make sense of what you are reading. When you write, you need to make sense in what you are writing. When you predict an ending, you try to think of the most sensible way for the story to end.

Example: If a story is about a person who loves the beach, all of the sentences in that story should be about the beach. If you are the author of that story, you will end with a good sentence about the beach.

Try this!

I love to go to the beach. I take a towel. I take a beach chair that is easy to carry.

What would you like to eat? Tell why.

- a] steak, rice, and a big drink
- b] sandwiches, cut up carrots and celery, and juice boxes
