

## WORDS WITH –CE and –SE

### What are the sounds of -ce and -se?

Listen carefully to the sound of s and soft c in each word: ace, case. They sound almost exactly the same.

Look carefully at the lists to see words with s or soft c.

**Words that end in -se:** base, case, vase, erase, these, please, sense, rinse, raise, horse, mouse, nose, pose, those, close, house, use, because

**Words that end in -ce:** face, grace, place, lace, trace, fence, nice, ice, dice, rice, niece, spice, mice, once, twice, dance, juice, science,
